Invitations for Applications for Post Graduate Degree in ICT

The University of Rwanda, College of Science and Technology is offering the postgraduate degree program in Information Communication Technology with specialization in Operational Communications at Nyarugenge, the CST main campus. Applications are invited from suitable candidates to register for the above program.

Program Rationale: MSc in ICT (Specialization- Operational Communications)

This MSc program is to produce highly qualified professionals for determining the ideal environment to introduce change resulting in the effective operation of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) and development of advanced strategies and solutions. This program offers a distinctive curriculum responsive to the learning and competence needs of ICT organisations throughout the world in general and the Sub Saharan Africa in particular. The program provides an understanding of the global environment of ICT with an analytical study of the nature of the business and processes involved. This program would greatly contribute to the achievement of the ultimate goal by preparing Rwanda becoming an ICT Hub for Africa.

Program Details

This is a one and a half year program and will start September 2016. The program will be offered in a modular based approach. It is designed to be more hands on and useful for employment.

Admission Criteria

Bachelor's Degree with Upper Second Class or Lower Second Class with relevant experience, not less than two (2) years or Equivalent Qualification in ICT related courses, such as Computer Science/Engineering, Information Technology, Information Systems, Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Telecommunications engineering, or electromechanical engineering etc. are eligible to apply.

Students with non-technical Bachelor degrees can be enrolled if they take at least four pre-requisite courses: 1) Data Communications and Networking 2) Advanced Programming with Java 3) Software Engineering 4) Project Management. Each case however will be considered individually and other pre-requisite courses might be proposed to the potential candidates.

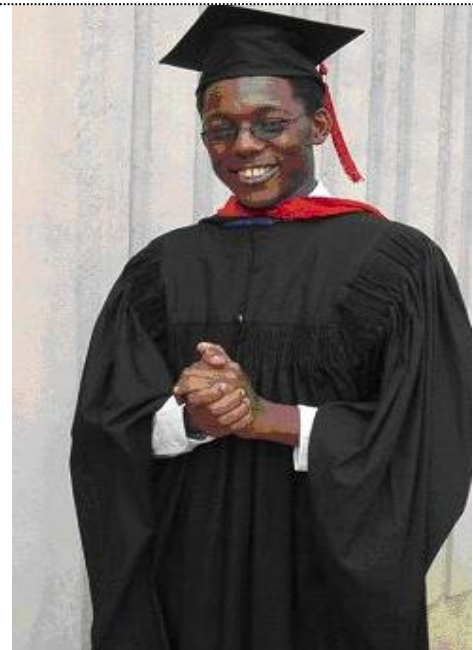
Candidates with non-IT related Bachelor degrees will be required to have worked for two years in relevant ICT Departments or Directorates.
