Call for Applications to the Program of MSc in Geo-Information Science for Environment and Sustainable Development

The School of Science, College of Science and Technology invites qualified candidates to apply for the program of MSc in Geo-Information Science for Environment and Sustainable Development (GI-ESD). It is a two years multidisciplinary week-end based program offered at Huye campus (see content attached). Applicants can be from different backgrounds including Agriculture, Biology, Chemistry, Geography, etc. The knowledge of Geographic Information Systems is a prerequisite for admission. Note that from this academic year 2016-2017, the tuition fee has been raised to 3,000,000 FRW (consult the registrar's office for more clarifications on modalities of payment).

Application forms are available from the Office of the Directorate of Research, Innovation and Postgraduate Studies (room A29, Administration Building of the College of Science and Technology). The deadline for application is 31st October 2016. Successful applicants will be notified not later than 14th November 2016. Teaching will start by January 2017.
