
The competition is open to anyone residing in Rwanda, including temporary residents.

The artwork must be submitted via [email address] in digital format (Only .JPG, .PNG, .PDF for Digital Photography and .mp4 for short video are accepted) of at least 180dpi for photo and for Short Video it should be greater or equal to 720p (4k, 2k, FHD, ...). The file must be named as "GREATER Art Competition - [Your Name]".
